***Where have all the Demos Gone?

Looking at my points lately, I noticed a very disturbing trend. Looking at my list of combat demos, I show 6 in 1998, 4 in 1999 and NONE in 2000. Now, I realize that I haven't made EVERY demo, and I remember 1 or 2 this year on weekdays that I couldn't attend, but the fact remains that demos, particularly demos for the general public, as opposed to collegiums, have fallen off dramatically.

Arts demos are faring a little bit better, but most of them are collegiums. Not that there is anything wrong with collegiums; educating our own members is just as important as educating the public. But let's not forget the public.

Finally, archery is new to our lands, but we have several people who are getting knighted in archery, and it looks like demo participations are going to be a bottleneck for them.

The reason for the falloff in demos is not hard to determine. Looking at the autocrats of the demos I have attended, (Yes, I keep that information - it makes it easier to make my case with the minister

of rolls if any of my points come up missing) I noticed that most of them are no longer playing.

This not only explains why demos have fallen off, but could be a factor in why these people are no longer playing. If a few people are doing all the work, burnout is often the result.

The solution, of course, is to NOT have a few people doing all the work. We have over 100 people in this kingdom. If just the members of the chivalry did one demo a year, we would have 1 or 2 a month, and more as more people get knighted.

So how do you go about doing a demo? As one who has done a few demos, I can give you some help on that.

Probably the best way to get your feet wet is to do a collegium. A collegium can be on any subject related to the middle ages. Most of them are arts related, but there is no reason one could not do a combat or archery collegium. Some possibilities for a combat collegium would be a class for people interested in fighting who are not yet qualified. Teach them the basics and then have them fight qualifying passes. Both the new fighters and the experienced fighters doing the qualifying get demo participations. One that I would really like to see is a class on war tactics. As long as you fight, it's a combat demo.

Archery collegiums have already been done, and with archery being so new, there is a lot to learn and teach.

A couple of things to remember about collegiums: you have to submit an outline of the class and get approval from the crowns at least 30 days in advance. You must provide materials (usually written handouts) to the participants. At least 10 people must attend (although this can be cumulative. If you don't get 10 the first time, you can do it again until you get a total of 10). The class must run at least 20 minutes. Finally, you can do a maximum of 2 collegiums for points in a 12-month period, and if you do 2 in a 12-month period, they must be on different subjects. You can do multiple collegiums

on the same subject if they are more than 12 months apart.

Now, let's look at demos for the public. I have done only one of these. And that one kind of fell into my lap, but the reason that it fell into my lap was that some people who might have an interest what we do (in this case, the calligraphy group I belong to) knew that I was involved in the game. Do you have your 'foot in the door' in some group or groups outside the game that might be interested in a demo? Do they know that you are in a medieval recreation group? Do the people you work with mundanely know that you are in a medieval recreation group? Even if they are not interested in a demo themselves, they may know or come in contact with someone who is.

Of course, if you have connections with the kind of groups that we have traditionally done demos for, so much the better. Are you pursuing those possibilities? Don't wait for someone else to do it; you are in the best position to approach them.

With a little awareness, we can get back on track, fulfill our role as an educational organization, and get some people knighted.
