OLD Crown Business - CRB 1: (Was CRB 4 - March 5, 2005 Est. Mtg.

Presentation/approval of Crown Writs ** Tabled for rewrite {No rewrite given to Chancery}**

1. Option 1 Umbrian Crown War is to be held the first weekend in December, and Coronation is to be held the last weekend in January.

2. Option 2 Umbrian Crown War is to be held the last weekend in October, and coronation is to be held the second weekend in December.

Counter-proposal to Old Business (CRB 4)

Counter-proposal 1- to Crown Writ Options 1 and 2

The Umbrian Crown War shall be held the second Saturday in April every year beginning April 2006. If necessary, the Crown War may be continued on Sunday, in accordance with Adrian bylaws. Field Coronation is acceptable to keep the date of War consistent as long as the formal Coronation ceremony is held within 30 - 45 days of Field Coronation.

An Interim Civil War may be called after the six month Pax Regium enjoyed by the Crown(s). Civil War is set for the 3rd weekend in October. A member(s) who meets the qualifications for Crown will notify the Chancellor of their intention to file for Civil War 30 days before the set time for Civil War. In the event no Civil War has been noticed, a _____ War shall be fought for the amusement of the populace.”

Commentary for both Crown Writ options 1 and 2.

The crown war as it stands now comes at a time of year whereby everyone has just finished celebrating Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year. At the end of January is not a good time for members as a whole to try to put together arts and funds for the event. We are also within the time period where the weather may play a roll in its cancellation. The two Crown Writ options do not have dates consistent with having a Crown War at a good time of the year.

Commentary for Counter-proposals 1 and 2.

The weather in April is not to cold especially if we want an over-night event nor would the Coronation be to hot if held outside. The March Imperial Estate Meeting is over and gives the old Crowns a good last event Imperially to attend. The new Crowns will have been in office long enough to have an informed and smoothly running Kingdom by the time the next Imperial Banner War in May can be attended along with the Imperial Estate Meeting that occurs in July.

The Imperial Estates meeting in March does not have a definite weekend appointed for holding the meeting. If it is decided to be held the last weekend in March, then it will give us a bit more time by having the Crown War the second weekend in April.

Counter-proposal 2 – to Crown Writ Option 2

The Umbrian Crown War shall be held the third Saturday in January in place of Kingdom Tournament beginning January 2006. If necessary, the Crown War may be continued on Sunday in accordance with Adrian by-laws. Field Coronation is acceptable to keep the date of War consistent as long as the Formal Coronation ceremony is completed within 60 days of the Crown War.

An Interim Civil War may be called after the six month Pax Regium enjoyed by the Crown(s). Civil War is set for the 4th weekend in July. A member(s) who meets the qualifications for Crown will notify the Chancellor of their intention to file for Civil War 30 days before the set time for Civil War.

In the event no Civil War has been noticed, a _____ War shall be fought for the amusement of the populace.”

Commentary for both Crown Writ options 1 and 2.

The Crown War as it stands now, does come at a financially inconvenient time of year. However, the weather is usually reasonably nice. Members know well in advance when Crown War is going to be held and can start preparations for the Crown War in all areas of contention; Arts, Archery and Combat. Research has shown that there are numerous Kingdoms/Duchies in the Adrian Empire who observe the 60 day period for Coronation. For the most part, 30 days to secure a location and prepare a nice ceremony and feast is rushed. Going out 45-60 days for the Coronation ceremony will allow for more appropriate planning, give more flexibility to budgetary issues and put Coronation the end of February into March. The March Local Estates Meeting could be held within a week or two of the Coronation and the Annual Participation Fee, due to renew April 15th, can be addressed by the new reign along with any other new business.

The current proposal on the table from the March Estates Meeting:

Option 1- Crown War to be held in December is a definite financial burden on members due to the holidays.

Option 2 – Crown War to be held in October would be a good time of year, however, locating and securing a place for Coronation Celebration in December will be near impossible due to holiday celebrations. In order to hold the Coronation event in December, funds would need to be allocated now and a place secured for the event ASAP and whomever the Crowns be will have to hold their Coronation at that location.

CHANCERY BUSINESS:

Proposal 1: Amend Estates Writ XVIV. Umbrian Participation Fee: (Passed March 26, 2005)

Amending underlined:

“All members of the Kingdom of Umbria must pay an annual participation fee in the amount of \$10.00 for the first individual, plus \$5.00 for each additional family member, with a maximum of \$20.00 per family. This will be due by the 15th of April of each year. New members joining after October 15th will be required to pay half that amount. As an alternative, members may pay a \$1.00 site fee at each Umbrian tourney event they attend, with no annual maximum.”

Commentary: It has been brought to the attention of the Chancellor that the language “each event” would include estate meetings. I see no need to charge a fee for participating in that event.

NEW BUSINESS:

Proposal 1 (*This action only to be discussed if the Estates vote for a permanent Crown War date*)

ESTATE ACTION:

The Estates of Umbria shall appoint a qualified member(s) to be Lord/Lady Protector(s) to serve from the end of the reign of Sir Pavo and Dame Margarita until the Coronation of the new Crown(s) in 2006. The Lord/Lady Protector(s) shall have a pax regium until Crown War in 2006.

*****March**

The March Chancellor's Report was sent in with all the Laws of Umbria for Approval. The Imperial Chancellor's office e-mailed me they received said laws and will notify us as soon as possible the results.

The newly approved Umbrian Laws were sent to the Chronicler for posting in the Mug. They can also be found on both yahoo group websites. Each time these Estates approve new writs/codicils or removes them the change will be made as soon as appropriate. The new laws approved by the estates at the March 26, 2005 meeting regarding fees for Umbrians and Non-Umbrians were voted to begin immediately. Members have until May 1, 2005 to pay the participation fee or pay \$1.00 per event fee. (this year only)

The change in the insurance coverage was sent to the Chronicler for posting in the Mug. All under-age children (under 18 years of age) can participate as List Mistress/Mister, enter the Arts and Sciences, Scribe and be a Waterbearer (outside of the fighting arena) until the new insurance coverage is obtained.
